**Subject:** Authorizing the Surplus and Disposal of Caretaker Trailer

**Scope:** The parking lot at Thomas' Eddy will be used by County contractors to store and stage equipment as part of Phase 1 of the Thomas' Eddy restoration project. A trailer on the property is no longer in a usable state and needs to be cleared from the site to facilitate the construction project. **Authority Granted:** Authorizes the surplus and disposal of the trailer and authorizes the Property Officer, or the Director of the Department of Facilities and Fleet, to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the surplus and disposition of the trailer.

**Background:** The County's restoration work at Thomas' Eddy will reconnect the Snohomish River to its floodplain at Bob Heirman Wildlife Park. The parking lot at Thomas' Eddy will be used by County contractors to store and stage equipment as part of Phase 1 of the project. A trailer on the property, belonging to a former caretaker, is no longer in a usable state and needs to be cleared from the site to facilitate the construction project. The former caretaker has voluntarily transferred the title to the trailer to the County. The director of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources has determined that the caretaker trailer is surplus to the needs of the department.

**Requested Action:** For Council to move to GLS on April 15, 2026 for consideration.
