**Subject:** Amendment No. 2 to the agreement with Quest Diagnostics Clinical Laboratories, Inc.

**Scope:** Snohomish County contracts with Quest Diagnostics for laboratory testing of specimens collected by the County or the contractor from County Health Department programmatic services. The contractor is required to comply with HIPAA and to provide monthly reports to the County on contract utilization, turnaround times, and any corrected reports.

Amendment No. 2 to the agreement increases the not-to-exceed amount by \$50,000, bringing the contract total to \$100,000. The contract period is extended until December 31, 2025.

Pursuant to SCC 3.04.14, services contracts greater than \$50,000 come to Council for approval.

**Duration:** November 13, 2023, through December 31, 2025. May be extended for up to four additional one-year terms.

**Background:** The original agreement laboratory services with Quest Diagnostics was executed by a designee of the County Executive on November 13, 2023, for a contract not to exceed \$50,000.

Amendment No. 1 to the agreement added lead testing to Schedule B Compensation. All other terms of the contract remained unchanged. This was executed by the Director of the Health Department.
