PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-036

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND SNOHOMISH COUNTY FOR JOINT OPERATION OF THE WINTER DOG PARK

Summary: The ordinance approves an interlocal agreement to allow the City of Monroe and Snohomish County to jointly operate the Winter Dog Park at the Evergreen State Fair Park in the outdoor covered arena during the winter. The City of Monroe operates a dog park at Wiggly Field, however, during the winter months, this location often floods resulting in closure of the dog park. It has been determined that the use of the Fair Park is consistent with the Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan and is in the public interest of County residents to participate in joint undertakings with local municipalities to increase recreational opportunities and facility capacity. A previously approved ordinance has expired, and a new agreement is required. The proposed term of the agreement is through February 28, 2025.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
