
- Codified in SCC 30.66A
- Fee schedule updated in 2024 with current population estimates & park projects planned for construction
- Fee schedule updated earlier in 2025 to accommodate proportionally lower impact fees for smaller housing units
 - Included coordination with School Impact Fee schedule table formatting for ease of implementation by Planning and Development Services Permitting Staff







- Current fee schedule format established in Amended Ordinance No. 2025-029
- Correcting the heading in Table 30.66A.040(1) is consistent with the intent of the previously adopted code update. Because the current table heading is a different defined development type, the correction requires typical Type 3 legislative action process.





Park Impact Mitigation Fees - Proposed Updates

Proposed fee schedule format

- The correction will delete the words "Detached Unit" from the heading "Single Family" in Table 30.66A.040(1)
- A "single family detached unit" is a development type and "single family" is a dwelling type category to which park impact fees can be applied.

Park Impact Mitigation Fees – Q&A



Note 1:

- The words "detached units" were never included in any previous Park impact fee table
- It was erroneously added in the "single family" header of Table 30.66A
- This proposal will correct the issue

Note 2:

- How will this correction affect the collection of park impact fees?
- PDS is currently collecting impact fees per the intent of Amended Ordinance No. 2025-029
- This proposal will correct the ambiguity in the implementation of the code's intention



Next Steps in the Park Impact Fee Update Process

- ✓ SEPA process & 60-day notice to Dept of Commerce in progress
- ✓ Planning Commission briefing August 2025
- ✓ Planning Commission hearing September 2025
- Council briefing, hearing & adoption –
 October-December 2025 (TBD)
- ✓ Implementation ongoing (intent for PDS is clear), formal adoption will lead to immediate implementation
