MOTION APPOINTING COMMISSIONER TO REPRESENT THE
LEGAL PROFESSION ON THE CITIZENS' COMMISSION ON
SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials is made up of ten members and was created to study the relationship of salaries to the duties of all elected officials and to fix the salary for each position; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is charged with filing a schedule of salaries for elected officials with the Council and Auditor every two years, beginning no later than May 1, 2008, and no later than May 1 every two years thereafter; and

WHEREAS, six of the members are selected by lot by the County Auditor: one from each Council district and one at-large member who may reside anywhere within the County; and


WHEREAS, the remaining four appointments are nominated by the County Executive. Of these four members, one each will be selected from the business sector, professional personnel management, the legal profession, and organized labor; and

WHEREAS, Cory Rein has expressed interest in being appointed to the Commission to represent the legal profession. Cory Rein is a partner with Cogdill Nichols Rein Wartelle Andrews in Everett. He has extensive experience in matters of personal injury, real estate, and family law, and has served as Snohomish County Bar Association President; and

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council hereby confirms the appointment of Cory Rein to the Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials to serve a two-year term ending December 31, 2024.
