<u>Authority Granted:</u> Approves and authorize the County Executive to sign Supplement No. 4 to Professional Services Agreement CCF02-22 with WSP USA, Inc. for the amount of \$384,206.00 for a total amount not to exceed \$4,139,888.00, under SCC 3.04.190.

Background: Snohomish County Public Works needs to replace Granite Falls Bridge #102. Built in 1934, Bridge #102 carries the Mountain Loop Highway over the South Fork of the Stillaguamish River. Public Works does not have the capacity to provide design services for this project and determined a need for assistance from a consultant. After publishing a request for qualifications (RFQ 22-04SB), Public Works selected WSP USA, Inc. as the top choice from among three responding firms to design a wider structure that would improve safety and traffic flow. Public Works has since processed three (3) supplements to the original agreement.
