Summary: The ordinance approves the PSTAA interlocal agreement (ILA) with Snohomish School District for the period of September 1, 2023, through August 31, 2035. The ILA includes the 2023-2024 Service and Expenditure Plan for \$26,859.63. In 2015, the Washington State Legislature established the PSTAA Fund and pursuant to RCW, Snohomish County is estimated to receive approximately \$79 million between 2019 and 2036 to improve outcomes in early learning, K-12, and higher education. The Council passed Amended Motion 21-089 providing direction to allocate funds to school districts and higher education institutions within the Regional Transit Area (RTA), in proportion to population within the RTA.


