NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on May 1, 2024, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance No. 24-023.


ORDINANCE NO. 24-023

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE  
TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE CONCERNING  
EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES

**Summary:** The ordinance approves an interlocal agreement for Snohomish County Fleet Services (FSD) to furnish equipment maintenance, repair and upfit services to the City of Marysville. Through negotiated interlocal agreements with local cities/jurisdictions, FSD has provided regional fleet maintenance services for over 27 years. These agreements provide the County revenue and economies of scale when purchasing parts and helps reduce overall Fleet rates by spreading fixed maintenance costs over a larger base. This new agreement was approved by the City of Marysville for the period from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2028, with an option to extend for one additional five year term.

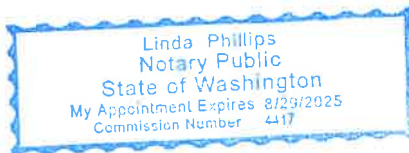
