Consideration:

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Ordinance 23-069 which would approve and authorize an amendment to an agreement with Whatcom County for the youth Cannabis and Commercial Tobacco Prevention Program.

Background:

Whatcom County applied for and received funds from the Washington State Department of Health for cannabis and tobacco funding. Whatcom County sub-contracted with the Snohomish County Health District to implement strategies aimed at reducing initiation and use of cannabis and commercial tobacco by youth, ages 12-20, in the North Sound Region. The agreement and Amendment No. 1 were assigned to Snohomish County as part of the county/Health District Integration. Amendment No. 2 was approved through [Ordinance 23-018](#) on April 12, 2023.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Amendment No. 3 would add \$14,928 to the contract. Personnel would increase by \$1,230; Advertising increases by \$9,821; Travel and Training increases by \$2,750; and Indirect cost allocation increases by \$1,127.

Duration: n/a – no impact to contract duration

Fiscal Impact: Increases the amount of money the Health Department will receive for work under the contract by \$14,928.
