Dear Mr. Jorgensen,

I am writing in response to Snohomish County's request for consent to grant a Temporary Construction Easement (TCE) to WSDOT for WSDOT's SR9 improvement project, per above mentioned easement. The TCE is for the following purposes:

Placing personnel, machinery and equipment on said lands and for providing a work area for a construction staging area for storage of equipment and materials and to perform all work necessary for the widening of SR 9, including but not limited to, planting, seeding, inspecting, monitoring, watering and weed control, together with rights of ongoing ingress and egress to accomplish said purposes (plant establishment).

TCE copy provided 4/11/24 and details provided 6/10/24.

PSE has reviewed the request and determined that we have no objection with the proposed use and activities as long as WSDOT (and their contractors) maintain adequate clearance from the 115kV line and that access is always maintained.

In order to ensure that PSE can continue to provide safe and reliable electricity to their customers, PSE must protect its rights-of-way from incompatible uses. In the event that PSE determines that WSDOT work is not compatible with PSE's use of the right-of-way, we will contact you to address the situation.
