### **Consideration:**

Appointing Kurtis Lewko to the Airport Commission to fill the vacant position for the balance of the term set to expire January 31, 2022.

### **Background**

The Airport Commission was established in March of 2017 through Ordinance 17-003, and acts as an advisory board to the County Executive. The Commission is comprised of thirteen members, consisting of one person from each Council district, three persons from the airport tenant community, three persons from the business community, and two persons from the county at-large.

Due to a shift in areas of responsibility at Boeing, Mike Catalano, who represented airport tenants, has resigned from the Commission. Boeing employee, Kurt Lewko has taken on Mr. Catalano's role at Boeing as the Everett Deliver Center Superintendent Delivery Operations Services, and is recommended to fill the vacant position for the balance of the term set to expire January 31, 2022.

To appoint Kurt Lewko to serve on the Snohomish County Airport Commission, representing Airport Tenants, term to expire January 31, 2022.
