RESOLUTION NO. 24-031

RECOGNIZING JUNE 2024 AS ORCA ACTION MONTH IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY

WHEREAS, in 2005, the Southern Resident orcas were listed as endangered under the Endangered Species Act; and

WHEREAS, scientists attribute the depleted Southern Resident orca population to a significant decrease in salmon runs, chemical pollution, noise and disturbance from vessel traffic, and loss of habitat; and

WHEREAS, according to the Marine Mammal Commission, the total number of Southern Resident orcas stands at 74; and

WHEREAS, the capture of orcas in the 1960s and 70s for marine parks is also a major factor. That practice ended after the Marine Mammal Act was enacted in 1972; and

WHEREAS, during the month of June, the Orca Network, the Orca Salmon Alliance, and other organizations collaborate to educate the public about these issues while working to improve conditions for the survival of Southern Resident orcas during a month-long concentrated effort; and

WHEREAS, promoting awareness of the orcas underscores the need to clean up Puget Sound, and restore and conserve important habitats, including those of the Chinook salmon spawning grounds; and

WHEREAS, we are fortunate to have this "urban" community of orcas in our midst, learn about them as individuals and pods, and watch them from our ferries and boats along miles of shoreline; and

WHEREAS, we have only just started to comprehend the amazing intelligence and social capabilities of orcas; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County supports efforts to recover this endangered population of Southern Resident orcas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Snohomish County Council does hereby recognize June 2024 as Orca Action Month in Snohomish County. The County Council encourages everyone to prioritize the plight of the fragile Southern Resident orcas, honor their presence in our waters, and help accelerate efforts to recover this important population.
