### **Consideration:**

Confirming the appointment of Robert Patrino to the Snohomish County Commission on Human Rights.

### **Background**

Snohomish County Code, Chapter 2.460.020, created the Commission on Human Rights in 2010. The Commission shall consist of nine members (one from each Council district and four at-large), appointed to three-year terms by the County Executive, and confirmed by the County Council. The Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the County Executive, County Council, Office of Human Rights, and other county officers and agencies in matters concerning human rights.

Robert Patrino has been nominated to fill the District 5 position on the Human Rights Commission. Robert has a volunteer history of serving other communities of residence, including being a planning commissioner, public safety advisory committee member, and parks and community services commissioner.

### **Current Proposal**

The motion under consideration would appoint Robert Patrino to the Snohomish County Commission on Human Rights, representing District 5. The term is to expire July 1, 2024.
