<u>Subject:</u> Contract with Colehour + Cohen, Inc., for Health Literacy

Communications

**Scope:** The Health Department is contracting with Colehour + Cohen, Inc. to

develop health literacy communications materials. The Contractor will create a COVID-19 communications campaign to provide culturally and linguistically appropriate materials to communities most impacted by COVID-19. Communication materials will address social distancing, transmission prevention, preventive behaviors, testing, vaccination, and

other topics.

The contractor will develop a workplan and timeline that includes the

number of communication materials and the type of media used.

The contract not-to-exceed amount is \$199,978. It is funded by an Advancing Health Literacy grant. Pursuant to SCC 3.04.140(2)<sup>1</sup>, contracts

for services greater than \$50,000 are approved by the County Council.

**Duration:** Execution through June 30, 2024. Agreement may be extended for up to

three additional one-year terms.
