PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4.121 SCC TO INCORPORATE FUNDING FOR ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING RESTRICTIONS

<u>Summary:</u> The ordinance amends Chapter 4.121 Snohomish County Code, Nuisance Property Abatement Fund so that money under this fund could also be used to help cover costs the Sheriff's Office may incur through the impoundment of recreational vehicles under the new code SCC 11.06. This ordinance is a companion to Ordinance 25-021, establishing a new chapter implementing parking restrictions.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
