**Subject:** Interlocal Agreement with the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District.

**Scope:** The proposed interlocal agreement is for utility construction associated with the Swamp Creek Bridge #503 Replacement project. The agreement will allow the County to include the relocation of approximately 473 feet of existing 8-inch ductile iron water mains and associated utility work in the project vicinity into the County’s construction contract. All costs associated with the AWWA utility relocation shall be reimbursed by the district to the County Road Fund.

The Swamp Creek Bridge #503 Replacement project is included in the 2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) and the adopted 2023 Annual Construction Program (ACP) as item F.54. Project costs are included in the 2024 Road Fund budget.

**Authority Granted:** Approve and authorize the Executive to sign the Interlocal Agreement with the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District concerning Utility Construction Associated with the Swamp Creek Bridge #503 Replacement Project, under RCW 39.34.

**Background:** Swamp Creek Bridge is a 41-foot long two span bridge that was built in 1960, between 228<sup>th</sup> St SW and 226 Place SW. It carries Locust Way over Swamp Creek between Bothell and Brier. Federal bridge replacement funds for the replacement project were received in 2020 and this bridge is identified in the [Snohomish County Public Works 2022 Annual Bridge Report](#).
