Subject: Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery (CLFR) Funds Interlocal Agreement with the Edmonds School District for Health Facility

Scope: The CLFR Interlocal Agreement with Edmonds School District No. 15 authorizes expenditure of \$1,315,269 in ARPA funds for the District to purchase and operate a permanent modular structure that will expand the school-based health program at Meadowdale High School. This program will increase student access to preventative health care and behavioral health services. The funds provided through this agreement will be used for purchase and construction of the facility. Work is required to be completed by August 31, 2026. The School District is required to submit a baseline data report, quarterly performance reports, and annual reports.

The building will be located at 6002 168th St. SW, Lynnwood, WA 98037. Site plans are shown in Exhibit B.

Authority Granted: Ordinance 24-073 approves the Interlocal Agreement Between Snohomish County and Edmonds School District No. 15 for Behavioral Health Facility (HCS-24-AR-2101-290) for \$1,315,269.00.
