1. Ordinance 23-011, approving grant agreement with Darrington School District to support prevention of and treatment for substance use disorders

Heidi Beazizo, Council Chief of Staff, provided an overview of the proposed agreement with Darrington School District as a subrecipient of a Health Resources Services Administration's Rural Communities Opioid Response Program Grant in the amount of \$150,000. She explained that the funds will be used to increase access to prevention, treatment and recovery services and support for individuals with opioid use disorder and their families
