

## Snohomish County Children's Commission Appointment Matrix

*SSC 2.410 created the Children's Commission, "which shall serve as advisors on issues of health, safety and social services for infants, young children and youth in the community." The Commission advises the Executive and Human Services department staff on matters related the administration and enhancement of children's programs. It is composed of 25 members, including at least two youth commissioners. Three members are appointed from each council district, while the remaining ten at-large appointees may reside anywhere within the county. Commissioners serve four-year terms with the exception of youth commissioners, who serve one-year terms. Commissioners may not serve more than 3 consecutive terms.*
