RELATING TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY FLOOD DAMAGE REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM; AWARDING PROGRAM FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MARSHLAND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT

**Summary:** The ordinance approves the recommendations to award the Snohomish County Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program funds and direct the Executive to execute Interlocal Agreement with special purpose district Marshland Flood Control District. The total grant award is \$120,000 to cover expenditures over a three-year period. The County recognizes the value of repairing damages to Special Purpose District (District) facilities to maintain flood protection to homes, County roads, farms, use of agricultural land and to drain flood waters after major floods. The County Council has established a Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program to help support local Districts in the maintenance and improvement of their flood management infrastructure. Funding for this annual grant program was included in the adopted 2023 and 2024 Surface Water Management Budgets.

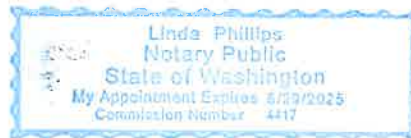
