Consideration:

Authorize the Executive to sign a contract with the City of Monroe Police Department for traffic control during the Evergreen State Fair.

Background:

Snohomish County owns the Evergreen State Fairgrounds and holds an annual Fair from the end of August through Labor Day bringing in roughly 350,000 people to the City of Monroe. With the significant increase in traffic to Monroe centering along Highway 2 near the Evergreen State Fairgrounds assistance is required for traffic control services to ensure the continued and safe flow of traffic.

Current Proposal:

Scope: The Monroe Police Department will provide traffic control services along State Highway 2 and occasionally Cascade View Drive as needed. The County will provide the City with reflective traffic cones, portable light towers, necessary permits, and other items as outlined in Schedule A of the contract.
