Subject: Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor Program Grant

Scope: Ordinance 24-108 would approve the interagency agreement with the

Washington Traffic Safety Commission under which the County will receive a grant in the amount of \$225,852.50 for the creation of a Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor Program. These funds will primarily go to

fund a prosecutor for the execution of the program.

With the contract commencing December 1^{st} , a budget transfer is also needed. Motion 24-481 would approve the transfer of \$20,244 from the

pending grants line in Fund 130 to Prosecuting Attorney's budget.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> For the Executive to execute the agreement.

Background: The Prosecuting Attorney's Office (PAO) received a grant from the Washington Traffic and Safety Commission for the creation of a <u>Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor Program</u> in the amount of \$225,852. This funding will be used for one full-time deputy prosecuting attorney. The current grant duration is December 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and the PAO anticipates continuation of grant funds in future years. The addition of one project FTE was approved by Council through Motion <u>24-459</u> in November. The two ECAF's before you are the final actions necessary for this grant/program: 1) interagency agreement and 2) budget transfer in 2024.
