<u>Authority Granted:</u> Approves and authorizes the County Executive to sign Supplement No. 6 to Professional Services Agreement CCF01-22 with Confluence Environmental Company Inc. for the amount of \$22,253.00, for a total amount not to exceed \$303,210, under SCC 3.04.140(11).

<u>Background:</u> In February 2020 Snohomish County was impacted by a weather emergency, and as a result the existing 12-inch corrugated culvert and Mountain Loop Highway over Goodman Creek was damaged. The Department of Public Works is working to replace the existing culvert and adjacent roadway with a new bridge over Goodman Creek, located approximately seven miles south of Darrington.

Snohomish County selected Confluence Environmental Company through RFQ-22-003SB following established Federal, State and County policies and practices. A Professional Services Agreement between Snohomish County and Confluence Environmental Company was negotiated to include all the planning, permitting, and stream habitat design from the 60% design level to final permit submittals.

Requested Action: Move to GLS on December 18th, 2024, for consideration.
