Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-057 which would approve and authorize and agreement with Allied Universal Security Services for private security.

Background

The prior agreement between the county and Parker Corporate Services, Inc (dba Pacific Security) was expiring¹ and the county issued RFP 022-21BC for private security personnel to provide security services on County property at various locations (locations and hours provided in Schedule C).

The successful bidder was Universal Protection Services (dba Allied Universal Security Services).

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-057 approves an agreement with Allied Universal Security to provide supplemental private security services on County property.

Schedule A: Includes a detailed description of rates by employee type for 2023 and 2024.

Schedule B: Scope of Services including background investigation requirements, uniforms and equipment, screening, entrance control, use of alcohol and other substances, emergencies, lost & found, overtime, personnel duties and standards and specific requirements for the contract supervisor, the lead security officer and security officers.

Schedule C: locations and hours of security services, including minimum staffing requirements

Duration: February 14, 2022 through February 13, 2024. Two (2) additional two (2) year term extensions are allowed. Termination is allowed upon thirty (30) business days' written notice for any reason.

Fiscal Implications: \$950,000 per year for a total of \$1,900,000 for the initial term²

<u>Future Budget Impacts:</u> YES. For years 2024 and beyond, Allied may request a cost change by March 1 in writing. Cost increase requests must provide supporting documentation.
