AJC welcomes the Snohomish County resolution condemning antisemitism. This important act of solidarity with the Jewish community both rejects rising violence against Jews and acknowledges how harmful stereotypes contribute to increased antisemitism.

Whereas, Jews make up only 2% of the U.S. population but account for over 60% of religious-based hate crimes, according to the FBI's 2019 Hate Crimes Statistics data.
