**PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-107  
RELATING TO THE 2024 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY  
APPROPRIATION IN GENERAL FUND 002, TO PROVIDE  
EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR UNANTICIPATED COSTS IN  
THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC DEFENSE, THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE,  
AND THE CORRECTIONS BUREAU**

Background: The ordinance approves an emergency appropriation in General Fund 002 for the 2024 budget year, totaling \$5,450,000, to provide expenditure authority for the Office of Public Defense, the Sheriff's Office, and Corrections Bureau. The allocation is as follows: \$2,750,000 to provide expenditure authority for the Office of Public Defense to pay for conflict panel attorneys and law firms, aggravated murder representation costs, expert witness costs, and in civil no-contact order cases as directed and funded by Snohomish County in collaboration with Snohomish County Superior and District Courts; \$1,500,000 to provide expenditure authority for the Sheriff's Office due to the CBA impacts, ER&R costs, agency staffing, and overtime; and \$1,200,000 to provide expenditure authority for the Corrections Bureau for the use of overtime and increased medical costs of inmates.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
