PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-019
DISSOLVING THE LOCHSLOY PILCHUCK FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 36.96 RCW

Summary: Lochsloy Pilchuck Flood Control District (District) is a special purpose district governed by the laws of the state of Washington and subject to dissolution in accordance with Chapter 36.96 RCW. The District was created in 2016 with all initial commissioners appointed by Snohomish County Council and elections have not been held within the preceding consecutive seven-year period. The District has not carried out any of the special purposes or functions for which it was formed within the preceding consecutive five-year period. The District has not imposed assessments on properties within the District and has no assets or liabilities. The District commissioners have declined to proceed with any proposed improvements and levying of assessments due to estimated costs exceeding district residents' ability to support the necessary improvements and the inability to obtain necessary permits. Snohomish County's Surface Water Management (SWM) has mailed letters to all commissioners and district residents requesting any feedback or concerns about dissolving the district, with no response. Ordinance 25-019 formally dissolves the District consistent with RCW 36.96.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
