A summary of the ordinance is as follows:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-058

RELATING TO PROPERTY TAXES; FIXING THE 2026 GENERAL PROPERTY TAX LEVY
FOR SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND PRESERVING FUTURE LEVY CAPACITY

Section 1. The annual amount of general property tax levy necessary to raise the amount of revenues required by Snohomish County for expenditure during calendar year 2026 is hereby levied upon all real and personal property subject to taxation in Snohomish County as set forth in the table below.

2026 GENERAL PROPERTY TAX LEVY

Use of Funds	Estimated Levy Rate	Estimated Levy Amount
General Levy	\$0.4734	\$112,821,793

Section 2. The amount set forth in Section 1 is hereby levied upon all real and personal property in accordance with certified assessed values and the completed tax rolls of Snohomish County for collection in 2026. That estimated property tax levy amount is intended:

(a) to include an increase above the County's 2025 levy amount as authorized by separate ordinance pursuant to RCW 84.55.120,

(b) to include any additional amounts allowed under (i) the new construction, improvements to property and state-assessed property provisions of RCW 84.55.010 and, (ii) as provided pursuant to RCW 84.55.070, the refund provisions of chapters 84.68 and 84.69 RCW, and

(c) to exclude any amounts in excess of the 2026 maximum levy amount resulting from application of the limit factor, plus those additional amounts described in paragraphs (a) and (b) above,

and shall be adjusted by the County Assessor when property values are certified.

Section 3. Any unused general property tax levy capacity for the 2026 tax year is reserved for future levy as provided by RCW 84.55.092.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

Public Testimony: All interested persons may testify at the time and place indicated above or by remote participation. The chair of the council may choose to limit testimony to three minutes in the interest of accommodating all persons wishing to testify. Written testimony is encouraged and may be sent to Snohomish County Council, 3000 Rockefeller Avenue, M/S 609, Everett, WA 98201; fax to 425 388-3496 or e-mail to contact.council@snoco.org. Submitting testimony 24 hours prior to the hearing will ensure that testimony is provided to the Council and appropriate staff in advance of the hearing.
