Authority Granted:

Authorizes the County Executive to sign the agreement with Ziplly Fiber in the amount of \$35,610 and further authorizes the Director of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to approve associated amendments.

Background:

The County has a current active road project on Elliott Road, which will construct a 40-foot clear span bridge near 12512 Elliott Road

Ziplly Fiber has direct buried copper cables between MP 0.42 and MP 0.57 which must be removed to accommodate the County's project.

The County and Ziplly Fiber have determined it is in their best interest to incorporate the removal of Ziplly Fiber's facilities, as requested by Ziplly Fiber, into the County's construction plans and contract for the Project.

Snohomish County sees this as a benefit to the County having a single construction contractor doing both the road work and utility work on site.

Ziplly Fiber has agreed to reimburse the County for the actual costs the County will incur in the removal of Ziplly Fiber's facilities. The estimated cost of the work the County is performing for Ziplly Fiber is approximately \$35,610.00
