PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-043

RELATING TO PURCHASES AND CONTRACTS; UPDATING REFERENCES; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 3.04 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

Background: This ordinance proposes further amendments to recently amended Snohomish County Code relating to Purchases and Contracts. The ordinance also includes housekeeping items intended to maintain consistency.

A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

<u>Section 1 – 3.04.015 Exemptions.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.015 to separate exemptions into two distinct categories, one for exemptions from the competitive requirements and the other for exemptions from the competitive and contracting requirements of the chapter.

<u>Section 2 – 3.04.135 Small works, roster.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.135 to reflect changes to RCW that concern the small works roster process and that become effective July 1, 2024.

<u>Section 3 – 3.04.140 Award, execution, by whom.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.140, to clarify the executive's authority to approve contracts for services and their subsequent amendments. Adding executive authority to approve contracts for county subscriptions or memberships in trade or industry organizations.

<u>Section 4 – 3.04.170 Rebid contracts.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.170 to align language with the county's bid terms and conditions.

<u>Section 5 – 3.04.175 Public work contracts.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.175 to reflect changes made to the small works roster process in section 3.04.135. Adding language to authorize award by manager and to increase executive authority.

<u>Section 6 – 3.04.180 Proprietary purchases.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.180 to change the authority and process for the approval of proprietary purchases.

Section 7 - 3.04.202 Services for which competition is waived. Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.202 to remove reference to executive authority.

<u>Section 8 – 3.04.265 Reporting.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 3.04.265 to exclude reporting of subawards funded by federal or state grants.

<u>Section 9 – 4.46.141 Personal property—Disposition of surplus property.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 4.46.141 to remove reference to deleted code section.

<u>Section 10– 4.46.201 Personal property—Disposition of surplus property.</u> Amends Snohomish County Code Section 4.46.201 to remove reference to deleted code section.

Section 11 Makes sections 2 and 5 of this ordinance effective as of July 1, 2024.

At the Public Hearing, the Council will consider a Proposed Substitute Ordinance, which removes the reporting requirement for subawards, as proposed in Section 8. The Council may also consider additional amendments to the proposed ordinance.
