Background

The Small Capital Projects Partnership (SCPP) is a council initiative authorized in 2012. The purpose is to provide supporting funds for small capital projects in Snohomish County to applicants who have partnered with a public entity on whose land the field or facility is located. The resource for this initiative is Real Estate Excise Tax II.

The City of Lake Stevens received an award for \$5,000 for Sunset Beach improvements in 2021; the work was completed in 2022 and an updated agreement is needed.
