Background

Snohomish County secured Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery (CLFR) grant funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Guidelines for these funds allow the County to transfer funds to a special purpose district of state or local government as a subrecipient. The Everett Public Facility District, a public agency under chapter 39.34 RCW, is authorized to acquire, own, remodel, maintain, equip, repair, finance, and operate regional centers, activities that are important to economic development in Snohomish County.

Current Proposal

The County wishes to provide \$562,500 of CLFR funding to the Everett Public Facility District as a subrecipient to provide government services in compliance with RCW 53.04.

This ordinance approves the Everett Public Facility District Interlocal Agreement, for the period of January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2023, in the amount of \$562,500, and authorizes the County Executive to sign the agreement.
