Type:	<u>Scope:</u>	The Snohomish County Health Department is seeking to enter into a data sharing agreement with the Washington State Department of Health for access to Washington Emergency Medical Services Information Systems (WEMSIS) <sup>1</sup> data. The agreement will allow the Health Department to view all of the numbers on the State's opioid dashboard. Small numbers are suppressed on the public-facing dashboard <sup>2</sup> to protect confidentiality. Under the terms of the agreement, Snohomish County is required to follow the DOH Small Numbers Guidelines in Appendix D to protect confidentiality.
