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Background: In June 2020, the Council passed Motion 20-212¹ approving a \$1.69 million grant award from the Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA) to implement a Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) program² from June 9, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The county entered into an agreement with the PDA on August 16, 2021 to reimburse for LEAD Project Management Expenses; the original agreement was approved by Motion 21-266.³ There have been three amendments to the contract and a fourth is necessary (and will be retroactive as the contract term ended September 30, 2023). In addition, a new contract to replace the expired one has been submitted for consideration.

<u>Requested Action</u>: Move to GLS December 13th for consideration.
