Background: The County and the Administrative Office of the Courts entered into an agreement, approved by Motion 23-238 to reimburse the County for extraordinary costs of resentencing and vacating sentences as required by State v. Blake. The amount of the agreement is a maximum reimbursement of \$2,631,056, which is not changed by this amendment.
