Hello Eileen,

The following are SWM's comments on the Town of Woodway's proposed Point Wells Annexation (BRB 2023-4). Attached is the "Financial Impacts for Annexation" spreadsheet filled out for SWM. In summary, moderate impacts are anticipated, and SWM program area and functions would adjust to the annexation and decreased revenues.

With respect to the PDS comment checklist:

1b. Applicable interlocal or service agreements entered into under RCW 36.115 or RCW 39.34 between a county and cities.

### Comments:

• There is an existing Master Annexation Interlocal Agreement (MAILA) adopted in 2016, between the Town of Woodway and Snohomish County. The MAILA remains in full force and effect except where modified by the "Interlocal Agreement between the Town of Woodway, Snohomish County, The City of Shoreline, and Olympic View Water and Sewer District Concerning an Annexation and the Orderly Transition of Services Pursuant to RCW 35A.14.292" ("Points Wells Annexation ILA") executed by Woodway, Snohomish County and other entities in October 2023.

MAILA Section 9.2 concerns surface water management service charges and services during the calendar year of annexation. Section 4.4 of the Point Wells Annexation ILA, replaces Section 9.2 of the MAILA in its entirety with an updated Section 9.2 with essentially the same but updated provisions. The Town of Woodway agrees that Snohomish County may continue to collect service charges and continue the provision of surface water services during the calendar year of annexation.

 Other provisions in the MAILA cover legal control and maintenance responsibilities, transition from the County's NPDES Phase I stormwater permit requirements to the Town's stormwater management requirements, access for the County to the annexed area during the calendar year of annexation, and governmental service agreements.

1g. Location of present/planned future community facilities.

Comments:

- There are no SWM projects, facilities, or known surface water or drainage easements. Any easements, known or unknown, would need to be transferred to the Town upon annexation.
- There are no present or planned community facilities. However, the Point Wells site is listed in the WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Plan for restoration, which the Town of Woodway may already be aware of. There are several options in the plan including full restoration and a partial restoration.
   Section 9.5 of the Master Annexation ILA allows for future possible collaboration with the Town of Woodway, should opportunity arise.
- 2c. Present cost and adequacy of governmental services and controls.

#### Comment:

- No change would occur during the calendar year of annexation. Over the long term, program service area and functions would adjust to the annexation and decreased revenues. however, some programs may have disproportionate impact due to funding structure.
- 2e. Probable effect of proposal or alternative on cost an adequacy of services and controls in area and adjacent area.

#### Comment:

• There will be an estimated impact of \$71,711.51 annual revenue loss after the calendar year of annexation. As noted above, SWM services will adjust to the revenue loss; however, some programs may have disproportionate impact due to funding structure.
