

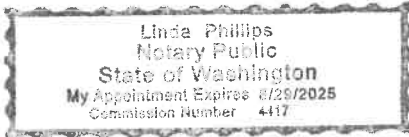




A SNOHOMISH COUNTY ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

Section 1. Adopts ordinance recitals as findings.

Section 2. Finding the unopened county road right-of-way is useless for county road purposes and the public will be benefitted by its vacation.

Section 3. States the unopened county road right-of-way described and depicted in Exhibits A and B to this ordinance is vacated upon satisfaction of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

Section 4. Conditioning the vacation upon the Petitioners paying the itemized costs and expenses under SCC 13.100.070 within one year of the adoption of this ordinance.

Section 5. Conditioning the vacation upon the Petitioners paying fifty percent of the appraised value of the Class B unopened right-of-way within one year of the adoption of the ordinance required under SCC 13.100.080.

Section 6. States the ordinance shall be recorded and effective upon the county council clerk receiving confirmation from the Department of Public Works that Petitioners have made the required payments and if Petitioners fail to make necessary payments within one year of the adoption of this ordinance this ordinance will become void and have no further force or effect.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.
