

2022 LAPSE REPORT

2.48.175 Lapse and reintroduction of ordinances.

A proposed ordinance that is not passed by the council by the end of the calendar year in which it is introduced lapses if not reintroduced, passed, or defeated by February 1 of the following year. A proposed ordinance is reintroduced upon filing with the clerk of the council with the signature of at least one council member on a reintroduction form approved by the clerk. A proposed ordinance that is reintroduced retains the number originally assigned by the clerk. (Last updated May 17, 2011)

The following Ordinances were introduced in 2022 and will lapse unless they are reintroduced by February 1, 2023.
