Association for Children Strategic Planning Demonstration Grant

Scope:

Snohomish County CASA will be opening a state-of-the-art sensory room and community connections center where CASA staff and volunteers will engage in recruitment activities, training, and advocacy for the best interest of children and youth who are before the court because of abuse or neglect. The room will be available to all children served and will be used for improving outcomes for neurodivergent youth and young

adults.

The Human Services Department is seeking to enter into an agreement with National CASA/Guardian Ad Litem Association to receive a \$20,000 National Demonstration Strategic Planning Grant for training staff and volunteers on the use of the sensory room and increasing skills for

serving youth.
