Councilmember Nehring proposed changes parking provisions in an ordinance attached to Motion 23-541. The Council discussed these on December 5, 2023, in Planning and Community Development Committee, and again on December 13, 2023, and January 3, 2024, in General Legislative Session. Apart from some minor rephrasing for technical reasons, Ordinance 24-059 is substantively the same was what the Council referred to the Planning Commission.
