MOTION NO. 22-383

APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE THE HOME
INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, SCC 2.400.030 authorizes the Human Services Department to administer and coordinate County programs and projects relating to human services in accordance with County, State, and Federal laws, and regulations; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County is the representative member of the Snohomish County Urban County Consortium (Consortium) for purpose of application, receipt, and administration of federal entitlement grant funds under the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Council Motion 22-162, the 2022 Annual Action Plan for these funds was approved on May 4, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Council approval of a grant work plan pursuant to SCC 4.26.025 shall provide authority for the Executive to approve and execute grant documents to implement the approved grant work plan in accordance with SCC 2.10.010(28). Such Council approval shall also provide authority for the Executive to approve and execute grant contracts for grants received in amounts up to \$50,000 greater than the amounts stated in the approved grant work plan; and


WHEREAS, this Program is included in the 2022 Human Services Department Grant Work Plan approved via Motion 21-362; and

WHEREAS, the actual amount of the HOME Agreement exceeds the amount included in the Grant Work Plan by more than \$50,000 and now requires Council approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, pursuant to SCC 4.26.025, the Snohomish County Council approves and authorizes the County Executive to execute the HOME Agreement M22-DC530201 in the amount of \$2,232,921 for the period of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, and any amendments thereto.
