### **Consideration:**

The proposed motion would authorize the County Executive to execute Amendment No. 4 to the software license and services agreement between Snohomish County and Cartegraph, Inc.

### **Background:**

In September of 2015 Snohomish County entered into a Software License and Services Agreement (“Original Agreement”) with Cartegraph, Inc. for an automated asset maintenance management system (Motion 15-374)<sup>1</sup>. Public Works has processed three amendments to the original agreement; two to extend the completion date of the agreement and one to provide additional but related services.

The original agreement allows for additional departments other than Public Works to use Cartegraph, and the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources wishes to use this software as its asset management maintenance system. The County and Cartegraph, Inc. have negotiated new terms (Amendment No. 4) which would allow for DCNR to use the software and acquire additional domains.

There is no additional cost to add a new department to the Cartegraph solution however, there is a cost associated with Surface Water and Parks specific domains. Domains are a bundle of Industry Standard Asset types that are installed as a package using pre-defined relationships and integrated system configurations for preventative maintenance plans and asset condition calculations.

### **Current Proposal:**

*Scope:* The proposed Amendment No. 4 to the Master Contract will provide the software licenses and support necessary for the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to utilize an existing automated asset maintenance management system.

*Duration:* The term of this amendment is from the date of execution to August 31, 2026.

*Fiscal Implications:* The total amount payable under this agreement will not exceed \$2,664,137 which includes \$318,525 for five years of annual domain costs and an estimated \$31,215 in tax for Amendment No. 4.
