ACTION ITEMS

1. Ordinance 22-018, clarifying process for determining lead department with lead agency responsibilities under the State Environmental Policy Act; amending Section 30.61.045 of Snohomish County Code

Ryan Countryman, Sr. Legislative Analyst, provided a brief staff report and explained the ordinance addresses the lead agency responsibilities under the State Environmental Policy Act and this ordinance would amend the code to clarify which departments would have these lead responsibilities.
