PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-103

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PORT OF EVERETT, CITY OF EVERETT AND SNOHOMISH COUNTY FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF JETTY LANDING LAUNCH

**Background:** The ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Port of Everett, City of Everett and Snohomish County for the operation and maintenance of Jetty Landing Launch. The three parties collectively acquired the 10th Street Boat Launch, with Jetty Landing Park facilities, in 1972 to provide recreation opportunities and have collaborated on several projects including some formalized through previous ILAs. The parties are permittees under National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) and State Waste Discharge General Permits (collectively the "Stormwater Permits"). The ILA delineates responsibilities for stormwater permit compliance that are outside the realm of tasks addressed by current ILAs. The parties intend for the Port to perform those obligations identified in this ILA and its exhibits. The Port's obligations would include performing a variety of routine repair and maintenance activities that have special requirements for stormwater permit compliance.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
