Consideration:

Motion 22-227 would reappoint Leah Everett to the Snohomish County Planning Commission (Planning Commission).

Background

Leah Everett was appointed to the Planning Commission in July 2018 representing District 5. Ms. Everett has served capably on the commission, including serving as its vice-chair. SCC 2.08.080 provides for renominations of planning commissioners. County Councilmember Sam Low is renominating Leah Everett to a second full term on the commission.

The Planning Commission has eleven positions, ten of which are currently occupied. Reappointment of Leah Everett would help maintain that number.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-227 would reappoint Leah Everett to the Planning Commission

Effective Date: Commissioner Everett's second term would begin at the conclusion of her first term in July 2022.
