**Background:** The Lochsloy Pilchuck Flood Control District was first created in 2016, with all initial commissioners appointed by Council at that time. No elections have been held in the preceding years, nor has the district carried out any of the purposes or functions for which it was formed (meets requirements/conditions for being considered inactive under RCW 36.96.010).

The district commissioners have declined to propose any improvements or levy assessments, due to the estimated costs of the proposed improvements and the inability to obtain necessary permits for the improvements. The district has no known assets.

Stormwater Management has mailed letters to all commissioners and district residents requesting feedback or concerns about dissolving the district, with no response.
