**Background:**

The Planning Commission is an 11-member advisory body to the County Council and Executive. Terms on the commission are four years.

SCC 2.08.080 states that it is desirable that the nominee has knowledge of:

- a) land use theories
- b) growth management and agricultural preservations studies
- c) have a minimum potential for conflict of interest
- d) have a demonstrated interest in the welfare of Snohomish County
- e) add balance to county-wide representation on the commission.

Angie is a resident of Snohomish County and this will be her second term on the Planning Commission. The term would expire July 1, 2029. County Executive Dave Somers is nominating Angie Sievers to the At-Large position on the Commission. Ms. Sievers has a BA in Education, has worked in the land use field and has served on numerous local boards and committees
