Consideration

Proposed Motion 23-132 would reappoint Angela Di Filippo to the Snohomish County Commission on Human Rights for an additional term ending July 1, 2026.

Background

The Commission on Human Rights is an advisory body to the County Executive, County Council, Office of Human Rights, and others in matters concerning human rights. (More details about the Commission on page 2).

Angela Di Filippo currently serves as the Secretary to the Commission and is a member at large. Her current term expires on July 1, 2023. She has indicated a willingness and ability to remain on the commission and to continue performing the duties of a commissioner. The County Executive recommends that the County Council confirm the reappointment of Angela Di Filippo to the Commission for an additional member at large term ending July 1, 2026.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 23-132 would confirm the reappointment of Angela Di Filippo to the Snohomish County Commission on Human Rights.

Effective Date: The additional term would begin July 2023.

Exhibit A – About the Snohomish County Commission on Human Rights

Snohomish County Code, Chapter 2.460.020, created the Commission on Human Rights in 2010. The Commission shall consist of nine members (one from each Council district and four at-large), appointed to three-year terms by the County Executive, and confirmed by the County Council. The Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the County Executive, County Council, Office of Human Rights, and other county officers and agencies in matters concerning human rights.
