FOR A SNOHOMISH COUNTY CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY THE
SNOHOMISH COUNTY CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the elected members of the Snohomish County Charter Review Commission, pursuant to article 8 of the Snohomish County Charter, prepared and proposed five amendments to the County Charter and have filed the same five with the county council on May 29, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the county council approved Motion 26-224 on June 3, 2026 directing the clerk of the council to transmit the proposed charter amendments to the county auditor; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1 relates to the adoption of a foundational government services policy, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, for each measure from a unit of local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval of the measure and shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' rejection of the measure; and

WHEREAS, each committee shall have not more than three members; and

WHEREAS, the county issued a press release and posted a notice on the County's web-site and social media notifying the public that citizens can apply to serve on committees; and

WHEREAS, an application process was established and a total of XX (XX) individuals applied to serve on the committees for Proposition 1.
