**Subject:** Data Sharing Agreement – WA Dept. of Health – **Child Wellness Survey Data**

**Scope:** This Motion would approve an agreement between the Snohomish County Health Department and Washington State Department of Health (WSDOH). Under the agreement the WSDOH will provide a one-time data transfer, at no cost, to the Snohomish County Health Department of the Child Wellness Survey data collected by the state.

The County Health Department may use this data to:

- Analyze the data as it pertains to Snohomish County and create a small summary report to give to the family health team to help inform their work.
- Supplement and continue epidemiology program work relating to child and family health topics.

They may *not* use this data to

- Link it together with any other information/data they have
- Identify or contact individuals.

All reports and summaries created from this data source must be provided back to the Washington State Department of Health Population Survey Team. The data transfer will take place on January 31, 2026 and when the County is done using the data, it must be destroyed in accordance with the guidelines in this agreement.

**Background:** The Washington State Department of Health conducts the [Child Wellness Survey](#) for families with children age 6 months to 11 years old. This data is used by the state to inform their programming and how to best support families within Washington State. An copy of the survey questions can be viewed [here](#). In accordance with [SCC 2.48.165](#), the authority to request information from other agencies rests with the County Council. Therefore, Council approval is needed of this agreement.
